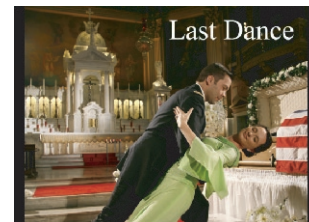

A young Vietnamese man yearns to leave the family restaurant business, but it takes an unexpected food delivery that leaves him running for his life.

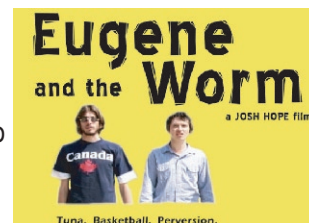
Windy City Ballers - US - 7 min.
