A businessman inadvertently offends a concrete megalith and has trouble ridding himself of his unlikely stalker.

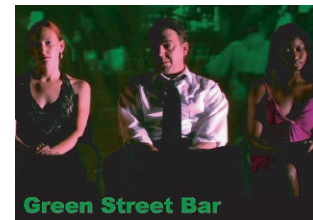

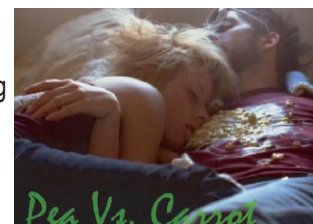
Sushi Bar - US - 10 min. - Directed by: Thiago Lima

Rejection - US - 8 min.

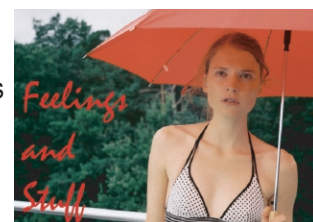
Directed by: Scott Sullivan
